EARLY PREPARATIONS: Handle the paperwork



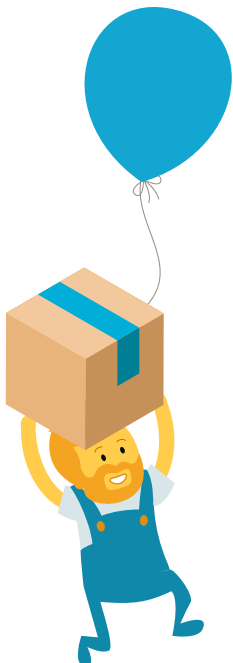
- Be sure to have your **ID card** or your **passport**.
- You will need your declaration of employment signed by your employer and your job contract.
- Get your **European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)**.
- Do not forget proof of the previous year's school enrollment for your children.

FOR YOUR INSTALLATION : Moving into your new place



- Open a French bank account**, this can be mandatory to set up utilities in your new house.
- Get a French phone number** : call this number **+33 977 557 227**, to ask a Selectra advisor to help you find the best mobile phone plan for you. (*Selectra comparator, not overtaxed, Monday-Friday 8:00am-9:00pm ; Saturday 10:00am-7:00pm*).
- Subscribe to a Home insurance** : this is mandatory if you live in a co-property, or if you rent a house.
- Set up utilities in your new place** : In France, you can choose your energy and gas supplier. By calling **+33 987 673 793**, you will be able to choose the supplier and plan best suited to you. (*Selectra comparator, not overtaxed, Monday-Friday 8:00am-9:00pm ; Saturday 8:30am-6:30pm*).

FINAL PREPARATIONS : Welcome to France



- Set up internet** at your place by calling this number **+33 977 557 227**. A Selectra advisor will help to find the internet plan best suited you. (*Selectra comparator, not overtaxed, Monday-Friday 8:00am-9:00pm ; Saturday 10:00am-7:00pm*).
- If you live in an individual house, you will need to **warn the water delegate of your arrival**. Follow this link to find their phone number : **eau.selectra.info**.
- Be sure to regularize your **car registration and insurance documents**.
